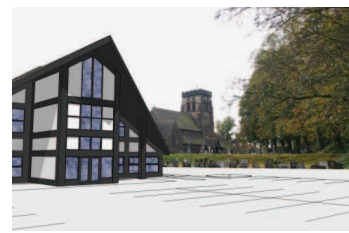

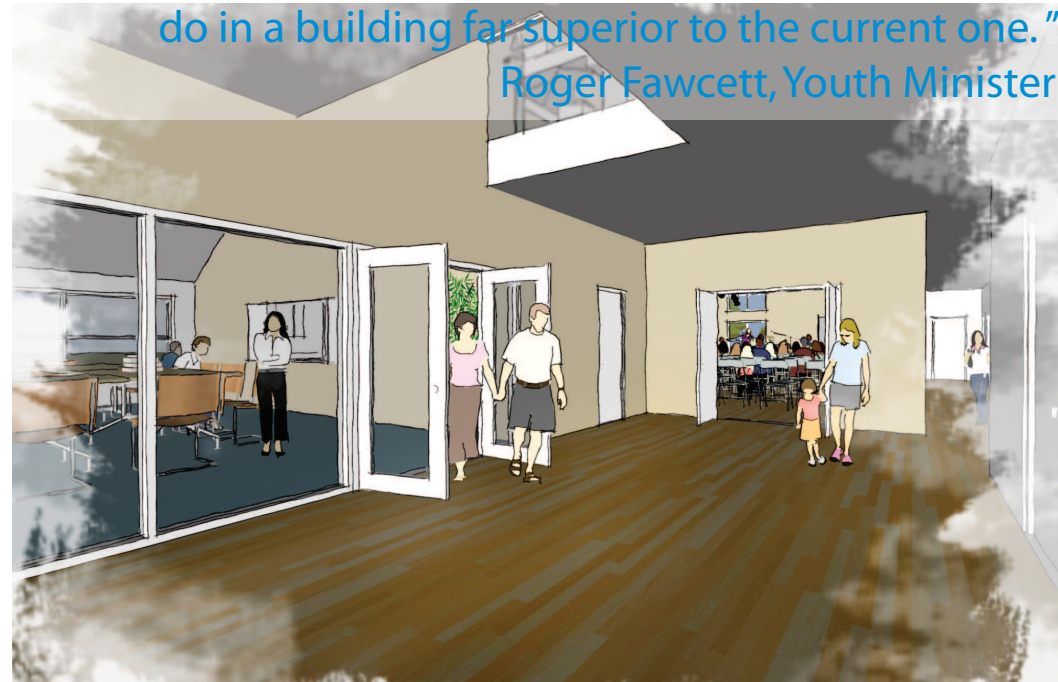
Where are we up to?

In September 2008 the PCC appointed a Design Team to take the project forward. We are currently working with this design team to finalise the plans for the hall, including final drawings, structural drawings and a cost plan, so that we will be able to out to Tender in early 2008. After a long wait - our new hall is getting closer!
