Nyakabungo PPS is located in a very poor area and is still in much need but impossible to fund from the families alone.

Darlington, the inspirational Headteacher, continues to work tirelessly and effectively with his committed and hard-working staff who are responsible for the education and wellbeing of in excess of 350 children from the “baby class” (aka nursery) right up to P7.

They are all currently enjoying their “long holiday” before the School year starts again at the end of January.

Despite their many challenges and with your invaluable support the children continue to perform very well in the National tests when compared with Government Schools in the locality and at the time of writing we await the outcome of the P7 end of year exams with anticipation.

The sports pitch continues to be well used and very popular, with goalposts in place and footballs, volleyballs (plus pumps/adaptors) and other sports equipment provided by our “Harambee” friends in Cheshire in regular use by boys and girls of all ages which is great to seeas well as join in!!
